Developing and Validating a Capacity Instrument for Chinese and U.S. NGOs - The proliferation of international research on NGO capacity raises questions about the degree to which existing NGO capacity instruments, which usually drew data from U.S. NGOs, can apply to the study of NGO capacity in other countries. To allow meaning comparisons of NGO capacities across countries, we examine the measurement equivalence of **Shumate** and colleagues' (2017) 8-factor 45-item NGO capacity instrument across a matched sample of Chinese and U.S. NGOs. Findings suggest that a revised 7-factor 28-item capacity instrument better accounts for the capacity of both Chinese and U.S. NGOs. Implications for the comparative study of NGO capacity are discussed.
